

Guild members names and Makers Marks are permanently recorded, they abide by set metal standards of material, their work is clearly identified as genuinely made in Australia and the year of manufacture can be recorded.

### The Guildmark comprises three compulsory marks: Makers Mark, Fineness Mark and Guild Mark

### The Date Mark of the Guild

Follows the convention established by the Worshipful Company of Goldsmiths UK and incorporates the current script letter in the Australian Guild distinctive square on its diagonal border. The date letter changes on the 1st January each year
